The sublime nature of the lake region

Enjoy long walks on the beach and sunsets. Visit the Jade stone shop and factory to discover how these precious and expensive stones are extracted and cut.

Your next step on your **road trip** is Kaikoura. Kaikoura is originally a fishing village known for its crayfish fishing and abundance of seafood. It is the ideal place to watch the whales and dolphins on organized cruises.

Your final step in your motorhome is easy. Make sure you stop at the seal colony just outside of Kaikoura for an extraordinary encounter with wild seals. Once in Christchurch, treat yourself to a nice dinner in one of the great restaurants in this city and enjoy visiting the historic city centre.
