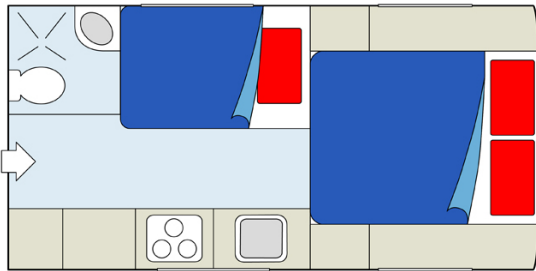
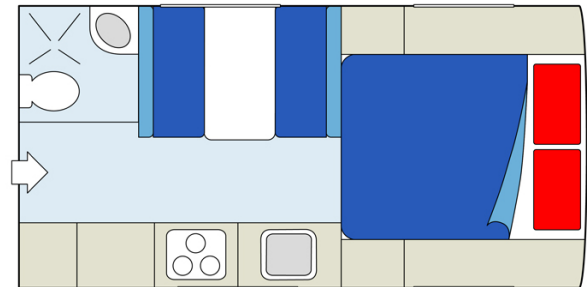

Batteries will last around 12 hours depending on use, and are recharged when driving the vehicle, or hooked up the 110V connection. Cigar lighter. Remember to take adapters to recharge small electrical appliances such as telephones or cameras.
