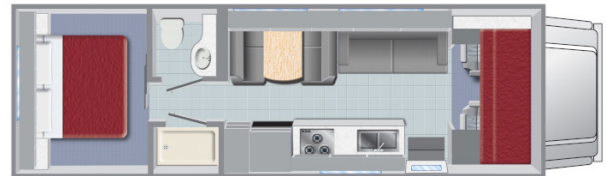


# Motorhome Ranger FS31 United States

Heating/Air Conditioning	Heating and air conditioning from the driver's cabin. Air conditioning while parked by 110V electric hook-up or generator. Heating while parked by propane, but also requires hook-up to electricity or generator.
Energy	<b>Generator:</b> provides power while not connected to electric supply for the wall plugs, microwave, air conditioning and heating <b>Propane:</b> provides for the function of the refrigerator and water heater while the vehicle is not connected to a hook-up <b>110 V Electric hook-up</b> <b>Auxiliary Battery:</b> provides power for the interior lights. The battery has an autonomy of around 12 hours and is recharged while the engine is running or connected to the electric hook-up. Please note when choosing you campsited to pick 30 or 20 amp connection. <b>12 V plug:</b> remember to bring your adaptors for charging your small electronics such as phones or cameras.
