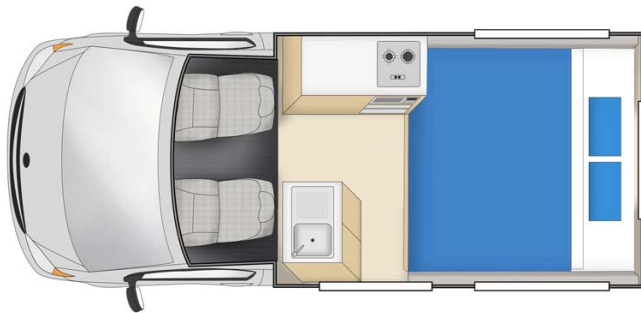


# Van Cheapa Hitop New Zealand

Energy	<b>Gas.</b> Allows operation of the refrigerator when the vehicle is not connected to the mains. <b>240V "hook up" connection</b> <b>Auxiliary battery.</b> Allows to operate the lights. It has an autonomy of about 12 hours and is recharged while driving or being connected to 110V. Please note for camping reservations, choose 30 amp (or 20) connections. <b>Cigar lighter.</b> Remember to take adapters to recharge small electrical appliances such as telephones or cameras.
